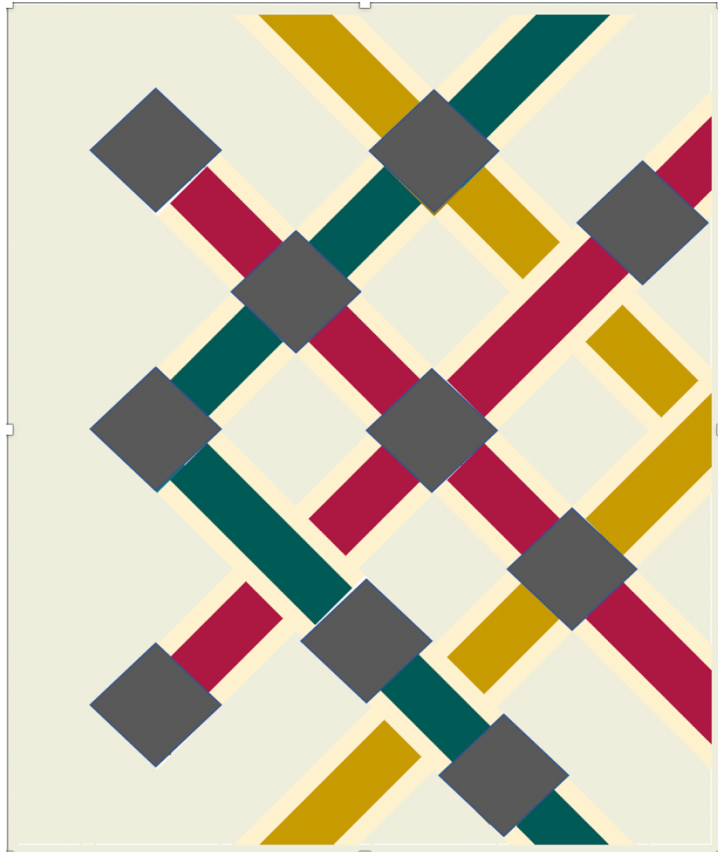

### Layout Option 1



### General Pattern Notes

1. The finished quilt will measure 73 x 87.
2. The quilt can be made larger by adding background fabric to any side of the quilt.

### Fabric Selection






1. I encourage you to use the coloring pages to test various palettes and color placement in your quilt.
2. The blocks are designed to be scrap and print fabric friendly. The background for Option 1 will require 3 3/4 yards.
3. To encourage you to play and test ideas, I have listed the yardage requirements for the blocks and the background separately. Feel free to mix and match.
4. The instructions and yardage requirement for “Licensed to Quilt” were written for non-directional prints. If you choose to use directional prints for any of the fabrics, you may need additional yardage and to alter the cutting instructions to maintain the directionality of the fabric(s) within the block and quilt layout.

### Materials

#### Blocks (10 finished blocks)

Fabric 1		1 yard
Fabric 2		2/3 yard
Fabric 3		1/2 yard
Fabric 4		1/2 yard

#### Quilt Layout Option 1

Background		3 3/4 yards
Fabric 1		1 1/3 yards (used in sashing)
Fabric 2		2/3 yard
Fabric 3		2/3 yard
Fabric 4		3/4 yards

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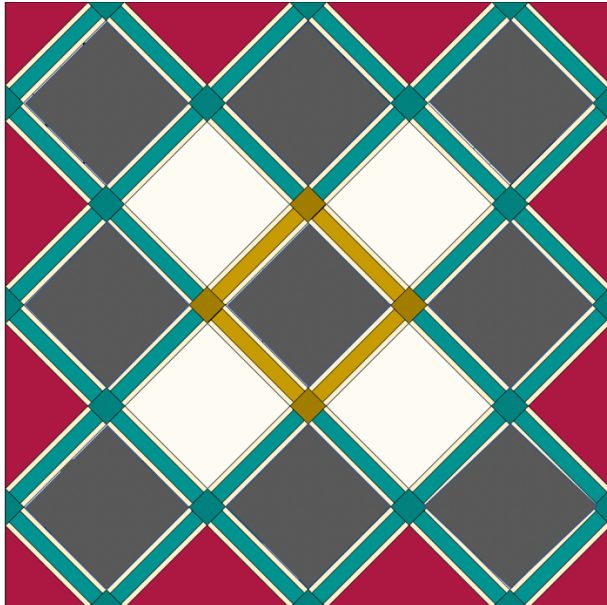
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## 2019 Block of the Month

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### Layout Option 2



### General Pattern Notes






1. The finished quilt will measure 46 1/2" x 46 1/2".
2. The quilt can be made larger by adding background fabric to any side of the quilt.
3. The instructions and yardage requirement for "Licensed to Quilt" were written for non-directional prints. If you choose to use directional prints for any of the fabrics, you may need additional yardage and to alter the cutting instructions to maintain the directionality of the fabric(s) within the block and quilt background.

### Materials

#### Blocks (9 finished blocks)

Fabric 1		1 yard
Fabric 2		2/3 yard
Fabric 3		1/2 yard
Fabric 4		1/2 yard

#### Quilt Layout Option 2

Background		1/2 yards
Fabric 1		1/2 yards (used in sashing)
Fabric 2		3/4 yard
Fabric 3		1/2 yard
Fabric 4		3/4 yards

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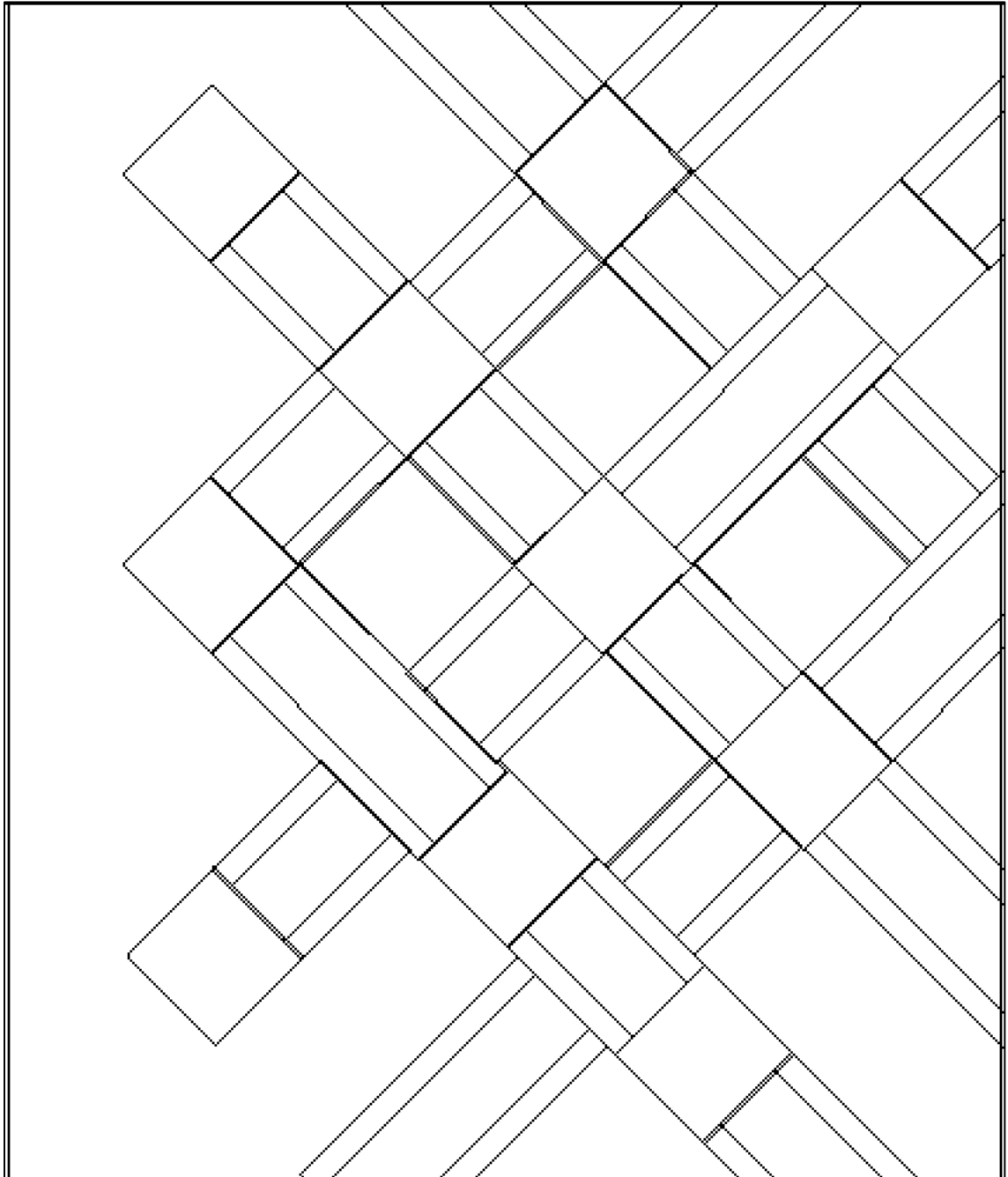

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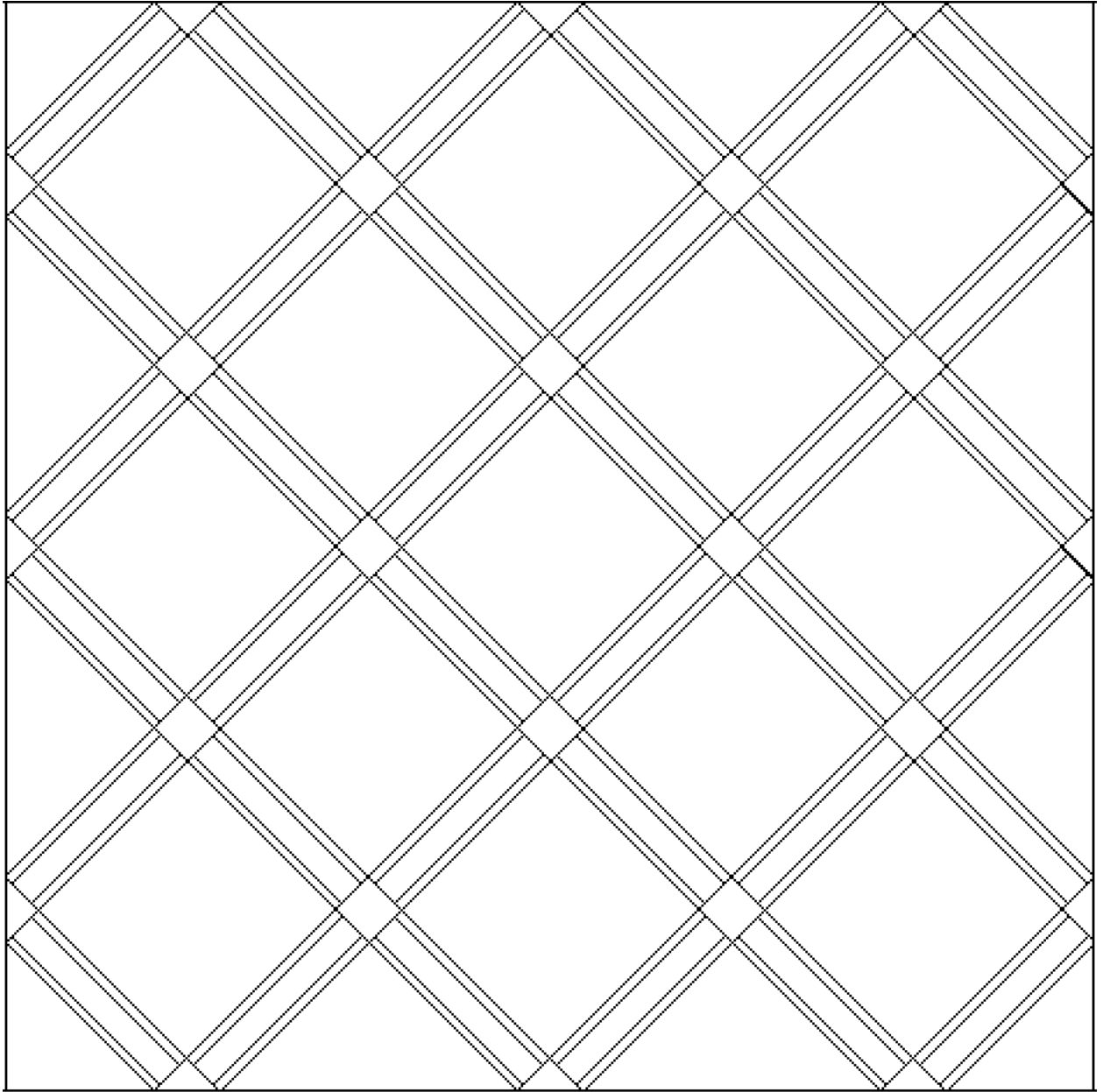
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### Coloring Page – Option 2



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
