

You will need:

Fabric 1 background Cut (2) 1 ½" x 4 ½" (D)

Cut (4) 1 ½" x 5 ½" (F)

Fabric 2

Cut (2) 1 ½" x 4 ½" (A)

Cut (3) 1 ½" x 5 ½" (G)

Fabric 3

Cut (2) 1 ½" x 4 ½" (C)

Cut (2) 1 ½" x 5 ½" (H)

Cut (1) 2 ½" x 4 ½" (E)

Fabric 4 Cut (1) 1 ½" x 4 ½" (B)

General Pattern Notes

- 1. The block will measure 9 ½" (9" finished in the quilt top).
- 2. Sew all seams with a scant ¼ inch seam allowance, unless otherwise noted.

Use of Directional Fabrics

The instructions for the Intersection block were written for nondirectional prints. If you choose to use directional prints for any of the fabrics, you may need to alter the cutting instructions to maintain the directionality of the fabric(s) within the block.


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Block Construction

Step 1: Create Unit 1


Sew A to B

Press Seam towards A




Sew C to AB
